

- Marriage status and certificate
- Detailed personal tax records

Protect against misuse of Personal Information

Include all types of information



- Information from GIS & GPS
 - Transport information
 - Tax revenues and spending in each province
 - Tourist arrivals and departures,
 real time
 - Trade and border trade
 - Weather data
 - Foreign investment data
 - Electricity, utility usage and spending
 - Education data




